



## Pacific Oaks College Articulation Agreement with South Puget Sound Community College

Pacific Oaks College, located on two campuses in Pasadena, California, is a unique educational institution offering upper division and graduate – level college programs in human development, counseling, elementary credential, and education specialist credential.

Transfer requirements for the B.A. are a minimum of 70 transferable units (105 quarter credits) with a grade of “C” or better. Minimum general education requirements must be met in the four areas of Oral/Written Speech, Science & Math, Social Science and Humanities/Arts. Transfer requirements for the B.A. or M.A. through the ABLE admission option is a minimum of 60 transferable units.

Students graduating with an Associates of Technical Arts in Early Childhood Education, and who have completed a minimum of 105 quarter credits (70 semester units) of specified coursework at South Puget Sound Community College, will be able to apply to Pacific Oaks College Pre-school-Third Grade Teach Certification/BA program. The students will have to complete all Early Childhood Education requirements for South Puget Sound Community College. Courses required for transfer into Pacific Oaks College are as follows, with the South Puget Sound Community College Associates of Technical Arts graduation requirements printed in bold.
